

DRS Accommodations

If a student discloses a disability and requests any accommodation for a course, please refer them to **Disability Resources and Services (DRS)**. DRS will work on any accommodation needed to support their success on the course.

Examples of accommodations and services DRS may provide include:

- Testing accommodations
- Notetaking assistance
- Assistive technology
- Sign language interpreting
- Alternate format materials



- Provide appropriate documentation to DRS
- Inform the instructor of their approved accommodations
- Follow the necessary procedures and timelines for requesting accommodations

Recommendation: Instructors are encouraged to include a statement in their syllabus and announce on the first day of class that students requiring any accommodations should contact DRS early in the semester.
